### Christmas Backpack Ministry

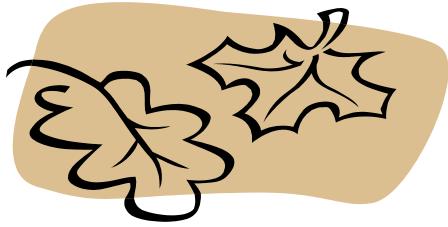

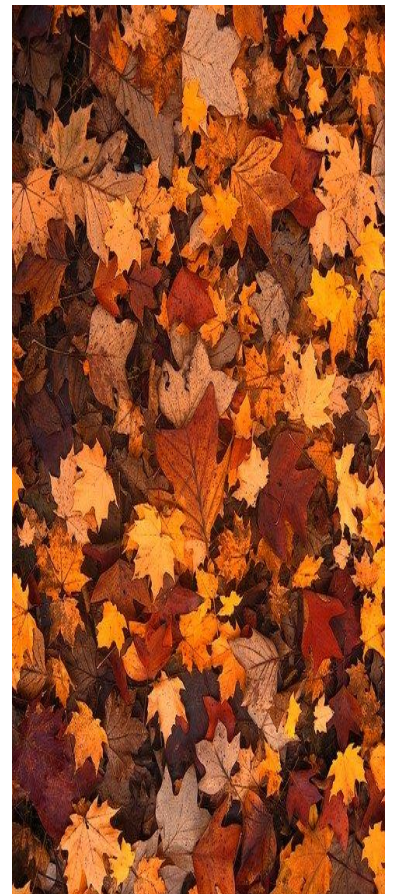
